Like going on a weekend trip to the Western part of the country, including Amsterdam and The Hague: Tour to the West. This way you learn more about the Netherlands and Dutch culture while you're here!

→ Offering young people the education that empowers them regardless of disabilities, social challenges or communication issues

→ Using creative means in daily social work situations

Early Childhood Education

→ Exploring and discussing the different philosophies of early childhood education
