First term payments are 65% of all fees due September 15th Remaining account balances are due in full January 15th

Zhang Wei from China in his second year of science, living in a private room in Governors Hall Tuition and ancillary fees (includes Inernational fee) Governors Hall - Private (Includes \$1000 DCB*) Zhang Wei did not purchase a meal plan Zhang Wei's total fees used to calculate his 1st term payment Zhang Wei's 1st term payment is 65% of the total \$34,886.50 X 0.65	\$24,461.50 \$10,425.00 \$0.00 \$34,886.50	\$22,676.23

Scholarship - students who receive a StFX scholarship use 50% as part of the 1st term payment

NS Bursary - Student who receive the NS Bursary use 50% (\$641.50) as part of 1st term payment

Late Payment Fee:

First Term - \$50 - if payment delayed beyond September 15 Second Term - \$50 - if payment delayed beyond January 15 Interest charged at the rate of 1% per month (12% per annum) on overdue balances on the last day of each month.
